

BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS

A candidate for the school board must be a registered voter and a resident of the school district for at least 12 consecutive months prior to the election. If the school district has a director district plan of representation, a person must be a resident of the director district in which he or she is a candidate. Some districts have a combined director district and an at-large plan of representation, which will involve residency requirements for those running for that director district. School board elections are nonpartisan. No person who has been convicted of a sexual offense against a child is eligible to serve on the school board.
