

COMMUNICATIONS WITH THE PUBLIC

The residents of the Peyton School District # 23 JT are interested in their schools as an extension of their homes, an extension which exists to perform a special function in the development of their children. Therefore, the Board shall make every attempt to:

1. Keep the public informed about policies, administrative operations, objectives, and educational programs of the schools.
2. Provide the means for furnishing full and accurate information, favorable and unfavorable, together with interpretation and explanation of school plans and programs.

In meeting these goals, the Board shall place great importance upon the role of the school and school level employees as communicators and interpreters of the school program to parents and the general public. Further, it recognizes that there are times when direct communication between school officials and the community is necessary. At such times, the Board shall encourage and provide these opportunities.

The Board shall report data on the achievement of its goals and objectives, educational achievement, and graduation rates to the public on an annual basis. Data concerning a specific school building may be sent to parents of students in that building.

The Superintendent shall develop procedures and techniques for ensuring a continuous and free flowing line of communication between the staff and the District's residents.
