

**DISTRICT ACCOUNTABILITY COMMITTEE**

The Board of Education shall appoint a Peyton School District Accountability Advisory Committee (PAAC) which shall make recommendations to the Board relative to the program of accountability.

An annual charge shall be given to the committee by the Board. Members of the Board pledge their support and cooperation to the committee as it examines the local educational program and makes recommendations for educational improvements.

The PAAC membership shall be appointed by the Board of Education, each to a term of three years, and shall as much as possible, come from the ranks of the School Accountability committees. Membership shall be as follows;

1. At least two parents of school district students
2. One Peyton school district taxpayer with no children in Peyton Schools
3. Two members shall be Peyton School faculty.
4. One member shall be a Peyton School Administrator
5. A current School Board representative will be a non-voting member.

The committee shall elect the following officers from its members:

1. Chairperson – The chairperson shall be in charge of all committee meetings and shall make sub-committee appointments as necessary. The chairperson shall meet with the Advisory Committee Chairpersons to maintain continuity in the district.
2. Vice-chairperson – The Vice-chairperson shall assume the duties of the Chairperson in his/her absence.
3. Secretary – The Secretary shall keep minutes and attendance of all meetings, issue copies of minutes to all members, and publicize all meetings at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting to the open public.

A succession of officers should take place. The Vice-chairperson should be nominated for chairperson in his/her second year on the committee.

**Duties**

The committee, no later than October of each year, shall meet with the School Board and accept a charge for the year which will be researched, documented and have valid recommendations formulated. A report with recommendations for district improvement shall be submitted to the Board no later than April 30 of each school year. This report will be made public to the people of the Peyton School District 23JT either through a newsletter of the news media, by December 31 of each year.
