

While the PPCC Testing Center is unable to administer Accuplacer on campus due to precautions regarding COVID19, PPCC has approved the use of EdReady as a placement option.

To take advantage of this option, students will need to:

1. Create an account in PPCC's EdReady Platform:
 - ppcc.edready.org
 - Students must use their PPCC assigned student email if they have one. If you do not have a PPCC email, you should use the email you included in your PPCC application
2. Students will enter the Goal Key for the course they are trying to place into:
 - ENG 121 or ENG 131: ppccenglishprep
 - MAT 103: PPCC_103
 - MAT 107: PPCC_107
 - MAT 112: PPCC_112
 - MAT 120: PPCC_120
 - MAT 121: PPCC_121
 - MAT 135: PPCC_135
 - MAT 155: PPCC_155156

***As of 3/1/2021, EdReady cannot be used to place into MAT 122, MAT 125, or MAT 166. Students may complete the Accuplacer to place into these courses. Students are encouraged to use the EdReady codes MAT_122166 or MAT_125 to prepare for the Accuplacer.*

3. Students will then complete the diagnostic test, work through lessons, and retake topics and units to earn their desired score. A score of 90 is required for placement into college level. A score less than 90 would place a student into co-req or college prep courses.
4. Once you earn your desired score, you must export your results directly to the Testing Center
 - a. Go to "My Account"
 - b. Under "Student data export" select "Download Your Data"
 - c. In the textbox, send a copy directly to the Testing Center: testing.center@ppcc.edu
5. The Testing Center will let you know when your scores have been entered on your student record.

Frequently Ask Questions**How do I know what EdReady goal key to take/use?**

Use the specific goal key for the class you are trying to get into. If you're not sure what class you should take for your major, meet with an advisor.

How many times can I retake an EdReady key assessment?

You make retake the EdReady assessment as many times as needed to earn a score of 90 for college level placement.

Do I have to pay for each EdReady key retake?

There are no fees involved with using EdReady for placement

How long do I need to wait to retake the EdReady key assessment?

You do not need to wait to retake the assessment, but you should spend time working through the lessons to improve your skills.

What is the minimum score to pass?

You must earn a 90 in order to place into college level classes.

How can I send my EdReady scores to the Testing Center?

Send your scores directly to testing.center@ppcc.edu from the "Student Data Export" in your account.

Can I use my EdReady scores to transfer to an other college?

No, at this time EdReady can only be used for placement at Pikes Peak Community College.
